1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant and learned A.G.A. for the State.
2. The present application under Section 528 B.N.S.S. has been filed for quashing the charge sheet dated 22.08.2025 and cognizance/summoning order dated 08.10.2025 as well as entire criminal proceeding of Session Trial No. 1235 of 2025 (Vikash Kumar and others Vs. State of U.P.), arising out of Case Crime No. 377 of 2025, under Sections 147, 148, 323, 308, 354(Kha) I.P.C. and 7/8 POCSO Act, Police Station Nagra, District Ballia, pending in the court of Additional Sessions Judge-8 (POCSO Act), Ballia.
3. It is submitted by learned counsel for the applicant that the applicant and opposite party no. 2 have entered into a compromise and they have amicably settled their dispute outside the court and no dispute is pending between them.
4. Compromise, if any, entered in between the parties can best be ascertained by the trial court, as such, compromise has to be duly verified in presence of the parties before the trial court.
5. Accordingly, for the purpose of verification of the compromise, applicant as well as opposite party no.2 will appear before the trial court along with original compromise deed in the week commencing 06.04.2026 and the learned trial court shall proceed to verify the compromise-deed. If the aforesaid compromise is verified, a report to that effect shall be prepared by the trial court and the same shall be sent to this Court on or before the next date fixed.

6. List this case on 23.04.2026 alongwith verification report.
7. Till then no coercive action shall be taken against the applicant.
8. Office is directed to return the original copy of compromise deed to the counsel for the applicant and retain its photostat copy at the relevant place so that the same could be filed before the trial court.
