1. Heard Sri Anil Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioner-Bank and Sri P.K. Shahi, learned Additional Chief Standing Counsel for the State-respondents.

The submission advanced by learned counsel for the Bank is that the reversal amount for dues of more than ten lakhs advanced towards the school would invite the application under the Recovery of Debts Due to Banks and Financial Institutions Act, 1993 and hence, the stand taken by the Additional District Magistrate that the land continued to be recorded as agricultural land could hardly have any relavance and significance and hence the order is unsustainable. He has also placed reliance upon the judgment of the Supreme Court in the case of *ITC Limited vs Blue Coast Hotels Ltd.& Others:AIR 2018 SC 3063*.
