1. Sri Prabhakar Singh, learned counsel for opposite party no. 2 preferred *vakalatnama* which is taken on record.
2. Heard Sri Santosh Kumar Singh, learned counsel for applicant, Sri Prabhakar Singh, learned counsel for opposite party no. 2 and learned AGA for State.
3. At the very outset, Sri Santosh Kumar Singh, learned counsel for applicant submitted that both the parties have already been entered into a compromise on dated 15.11.2025 but the same has not been preferred before learned court concerned.
4. Learned counsel for both the parties are hereby requested to advice their clients i.e. applicant and opposite party nos. 2 to file compromise deed dated 15.11.2025 before learned court of Additional Civil Judge (J.D.), Ist, Jalaun at Orai within 15 days from today.
5. In case, the said compromise deed is filed within the stipulated period, learned court of Additional Civil Judge (J.D.), Ist, Jalaun at Orai shall verify the same in presence of both the parties within a period of four weeks thereafter and send its report to this Court through the Registry on or before the next date.
6. List this case in week commencing 6.4.2026 along with said report.

7. Registrar (Compliance) is hereby directed to serve a copy of this order upon learned court of Additional Civil Judge (J.D.), Ist, Jalaun at Orai within **next three working days** and after receiving verification report, same may be placed in record of this matter, so that the matter may be adjudicated on the basis of verification report.

8. Till the next date of listing, no coercive action shall be initiated against the applicant herein in pursuance to Case no. 1695 of 2019 arising out of Case Crime no. 828 of 2018 (State of U.P. vs. Dinesh Kumar Verma) under sections 286/504/506 IPC at PS- Kotwali Orai, District Jalaun which has not been disputed by Sri Prabhakar Singh, learned counsel for opposite party no. 2.
