1. Heard Sri Kumar Dhananjay, learned counsel for the applicant and Sri S.K. Ojha, learned AGA-I for the State.
2. The instant application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed seeking quashing of the summoning order dated 12.09.2023 as well as the entire proceeding of Complaint Case No. 127368 of 2022 (Smt. Poorvi Agarwal vs. Manish) under Sections 323, 506 IPC, P.S. Mahila Thana, Ghaziabad, pending before the court of Civil Judge (Jr. Division) / F.T.C.-I (Crime against Women), Ghaziabad.
3. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant is the husband of opposite party no.2 and there are various matrimonial disputes between them and the instant case is nothing but a continuation of the matrimonial dispute for which the instant complaint case has been lodged by the opposite party no.2 to put pressure upon the applicant herein. Learned counsel for applicant submits that if an opportunity is granted to the parties there is a possibility of amicable settlement of dispute through the mediation centre of this Court.
4. Learned counsels for the parties admit that there are chances of reconciliation between the parties.
5. In view of the aforesaid submission, the instant case is referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court subject to deposit of a sum of Rs. 35,000/- by the applicant by way of demand draft / pay order in the name of Registrar General A/c, Allahabad High Court Mediation & Conciliation Centre within a period of two weeks from today. After deposit of the aforesaid amount, the Mediation Centre shall send a notice to the opposite party no.2 fixing **14.09.2025** to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court on the date fixed in the notice. Out of aforesaid amount, a sum of Rs. 10,000/- shall be payable to the opposite party no.2 on her first appearance, Rs. 10,000/- on her second appearance and Rs. 10,000/- on her third appearance or final settlement, whichever

is earlier before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre. The balance amount of Rs. 5,000/- shall be retained by the Mediation Centre towards cost of Mediation. The Mediation Centre shall submit its report in the matter within three months.

7. List this case on **18.11.2025** before the appropriate Bench.

8. In view of the fact as noted above and that the matter has been referred for mediation at the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, High Court, Allahabad, as an interim measure it is provided that no coercive action shall be taken against applicant till the next date of listing, from the date of deposit of amount as directed herein above.

9. However, it is provided that if the amount, as directed above, is not deposited by the applicant within the aforesaid period, the protection granted to the applicant shall automatically stand vacated and the instant application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. shall stand dismissed, without any further reference to the Court.
