HON'BLE AVNISH SAXENA, J.

1. Sri Bhaskar Bhadra, learned counsel for the accused-applicant submits that the applicant and victim are husband and wife having a child. The FIR of enticement has been lodged by father of victim. Presently, the applicant, informant and victim have buried their differences and entered into compromise. He submits that the witnesses have been examined before the court who have turned hostile. Hence seeks intervention of this Court to quash the charge sheet and further proceedings.

2. Sri Rajveer Chauraisa, learned counsel for opposite party no.3, victim and informant appeared and hands up Vakalatnama, the same is taken on record. The name of learned counsel be shown in the cause list. Learned counsel admits the factum of marriage and compromise entered into between the parties.

3. Learned AGA for the State-opposite party no.1 is present.

4. None appears for the opposite party nos. 2 and 4.

5. List on 06.02.2026 amongst top ten cases.

6. In the meantime, the parties may exchange affidavits.

7. The parties may appear before the trial court and file the compromise entered into between the parties, which shall be verified by the trial court. The trial court may return the certified copy of compromise, keeping the original in the record, to this Court at an early date.

8. Considering the marriage and compromise entered between the parties, the further proceeding of Case No. 09 of 2024 (State Vs. Sonu), arising out of Case Crime No.129 of 2023, under Sections 363, 366, 376 IPC and Section 3/4(2) of POCSO Act, P.S. Hafizganj, District Bareilly shall remain stayed.
