1. The case is taken up on mentioning.
2. Heard Sri Subhash Chandra, learned counsel for the applicants, Sri Santosh Kumar Yadav, learned counsel for the opposite party no.2, Sri B. P. Singh learned AGA for the State-opposite party no.1.
3. This application u/s 482 Cr.P.C. has been preferred for quashing of the entire proceeding of S. S. T. No.367 of 2018 (State Vs. Vijendra Singh & Others), under sections 420, 467, 323, 452, 506, 504, IPC and section 3(1)da, 3(1)Dha, 3(1)Cha of SC/ST Act, Police Station Dauki, District Agra, arising out of Case Crime No.466 of 2017, under sections 420, 467, 323, 452, 504, 506, IPC, Police Station Dauki, District Agra, in pursuance to the of compromise dated 19.11.2024.
4. It is contended by learned counsel for the applicants that dispute between the applicants and opposite party no.2 relates to some civil dispute. It is further contended by learned counsel for the applicants that applicants and opposite party no.2 have entered into compromise and certified copy of the compromise is already on record as annexure No.3 to the memo of application. He further submits that said compromise needs to be verified by the learned court concerned and he prays that same may be sent to the court concerned i.e. learned Special Judge (SC/ST Act), Agra, for verification.

5. On the other hand, learned AGA for the State as well as learned counsel for opposite party no.2 have no objection to the above submissions of learned counsel of the applicants.

6. In view of the above, office is directed to send the certified copy of compromise to the court concerned i.e. learned Special Judge (SC/ST Act), Agra, for verification of the same. The applicants and opposite party no.2 are directed to appear before the court concerned on 29.09.2025.

7. Learned court concerned i.e. learned Special Judge (SC/ST Act), Agra, shall verify the compromise in the presence of both the parties and submit a compromise verification report to this Court, within two weeks thereafter.

8. Learned counsel for the applicants may also file a supplementary affidavit bringing on record the proceedings of the compromise verification, within two weeks, after verification of the compromise.

9. List this case on 30.10.2025, as fresh, before the appropriate Bench.

10. Till the next date of listing no coercive action shall be taken against the applicant in the aforesaid case.
