HON'BLE DR. GAUTAM CHOWDHARY, J.

1. Heard Shri Ashutosh Kumar Shukla, learned counsel for the applicant, Shri Chandan Singh, learned A.G.A. for the State as well as Shri Ankit Mishra, learned counsel for the informant and perused the material brought on record.
2. The allegation against the applicant is that on the pretext of false promise of marriage he had established physical relations with the victim, thereafter, he refused to marry her and due to such relations developed between them the victim has become pregnant.
3. At the very outset learned counsel for the applicant submits that applicant is ready to marry the victim, which fact has also been stated in para-22 of the affidavit filed in support of the bail application, therefore, he may be enlarged on interim bail.
4. Learned counsel for the informant submits that since both the victim and the applicant are ready to solemnize marriage, therefore, he has no objection. However, he stated that the applicant may be granted interim bail for a short period.
5. Learned A.G.A. for the State has also no objection to the prayer made on behalf of applicant.
6. Considering the overall facts and circumstances, the nature of allegations, the gravity of offence and without expressing any opinion on

merits and considering the fact that both the victim and the applicant are ready solemnize marriage with each other, this Court directs that the applicant be enlarged on interim bail till the next date of listing.

7. Let the applicant-Virendra Vishwakarma, be enlarged on interim bail till the next date fixed in Case Crime No. 194 of 2025, under Sections 69, 115(2), 352, 351(3) BNS, Police Station- Kubersthan, District-Kushinagar, on executing a personal bond and furnishing two local sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of the court concerned with the following conditions:

- i) The applicant shall solemnize the marriage with the victim within two weeks of his release and shall apply and get his marriage registered with the Registrar concerned and produce the registration certificate of the said marriage before this Court by filing supplementary affidavit on the next date fixed.
- ii) The applicant shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence.
- ii) The applicant shall not threaten or harass the prosecution witnesses.
- iii) The applicant shall appear on the date fixed by the trial court.
- iv) The applicant shall not commit any offence similar to the offence of which the applicant is accused, or suspected of the commission.
- v) The applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade such person from disclosing facts to the Court or to any police officer or tamper with the evidence.

8. In failure to comply this order, the interim bail granted today to the applicant shall stand cancelled and he shall be taken into custody forthwith.

9. List this case on 09.02.2026. On that date both the victim and applicant shall also appear before this Court.
