1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant and learned A.G.A. for the State.
2. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the applicant that only one case has been mentioned against the applicant in gang chart and in that case he has been acquitted by the learned trial court vide judgment and order dated 6.11.2025 in S.T. No. 590 of 2023. It is further submitted that once in the base case applicant has been acquitted, the instant proceedings under the Gangster Act cannot be drawn. In support of his submission, learned counsel for the applicant relied upon a judgment of Apex Court in **Farhana vs. State of Uttar Pradesh and others [2024 0 INSC 118]**.
3. At this stage, learned A.G.A. prays for and is granted two weeks time to enable him to obtain instructions in the matter.
4. Put up this case on 19.01.2026, as fresh.
5. Till the next date of listing, further proceedings of Sessions Case No. 309 of 2023, arising out of Case Crime No. 270 of 2021, under Section 3(1) of U.P. Gangster Act, P.S. Rajjabpur, District J.P. Nagar (Amroha), as well as chargesheet dated 26.5.2022, and cognizance/summoning order dated 27.4.2023, pending in the court of Additional Sessions Judge/Fast Track Court-II, J.P. Nagar (Amroha), shall remain stayed against the applicant only.
