Heard learned counsel for the applicant, learned A.G.A. for the State and perused the record.

The present application under Section 528 B.N.S.S. has been preferred to stay the effect and operation of the impugned execution order dated 30.10.2025 passed by Principal Judge, Family Court, Azamgarh in the execution (Izara) Case No. 208 of 2024 (Neeraj Vs. Prabhakar) under Section 128 Cr.P.C. and to grant some more time to deposit the recovery of outstanding maintenance amount of Rs. 3,16,000/- in easy installments, awarded by the order dated 30.10.2025 passed by Principal Judge, Family Court, Azamgarh in the execution (Izara) Case No. 208 of 2024 (Neerj Vs. Prabhakar) under Section 128 Cr.P.C. arising out of Original Case No. 1079 of 2017 (Neeraj Vs. Prabhakar) under Section 125 Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the applicant states that the applicant consents to refer the matter to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, High Court Allahabad, for amicable settlement of the dispute.

Accordingly, the matter is referred to Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court. The applicant is directed to deposit a sum of Rs. 1,05,000/- by way of demand draft/pay order in the name of Allahabad High Court, Mediation and Conciliation Centre (AHCMCC) within a period of 15 days from today. Out of total amount, Rs. 1,00,000/- shall be payable to the opposite party No. 2 on her appearance before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre which shall be adjusted towards the maintenance

amount due to be paid to opposite party No. 2 and remaining Rs. 5,000/- shall be payable to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre.

The matter is referred to the Mediation Centre with the direction that same may be tried to be resolved after giving notices to the opposite parties. The Mediation Centre will submit its report in the matter within three months.

List this case on 10.03.2026 in the daily cause list before the appropriate Bench alongwith the report of Mediation Centre.

In case, the applicant is not deposited the aforesaid amount within the stipulated period, list this case immediately before this Court.
