**HON'BLE DINESH PATHAK, J.**

1. Sri Ayub Khan, learned Advocate, submits that he has filed a caveat application on behalf of Smt. Prem Lata. However, neither has she been impleaded as a party in the cause title of the instant writ petition nor is she affected by the order under Challenge, therefore, his name may be ordered to be expunged as counsel for the respondent. His prayer is allowed.
2. Office is directed to expunge the name of Sri Ayub Khan, learned Advocate, as counsel for the respondent.
3. The petitioner has assailed the order passed by the Settlement Officer of Consolidation and the Deputy Director of Consolidation, whereby plot nos.298/1 and 298/2 have been earmarked for the pond; however, the gaon sabha has been made a party in the instant writ petition.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has prayed for and is permitted to implead Gaon Sabha in the cause title of the instant writ petition during the course of the day and to serve notice upon learned counsel for the Gaon Sabha.
5. List this matter again as **fresh on 20.1.2026.**
