HON'BLE CHAWAN PRAKASH, J.

1. Heard Sri Anupam Dubey, learned counsel for applicant, Sri Sohit Prakash Sharma, learned counsel for opposite party No.2 and learned AGA for the State.

2. The applicants have invoked the inherent jurisdiction of this Court under Section 528 BNSS to quash the charge sheet dated 23.5.2025 along with summoning order dated 19.08.2025 as well as entire proceeding of Crl. Case No.13151 of 2025 (State Vs. Rajendra Singh and others), arising out of Case Crime No.114 of 2025, under Sections 386, 387, 388, 389, 506, 190, 1888 and 120-B I.P.C., P.S. Surajpur, District Gautam Buddh Nagar, pending in the Court of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-II, District Gautam Budh Nagar.

3. It is submitted that during pendency of the criminal proceedings, both the parties have arrived at a compromise and settled their dispute amicably out of the Court. Therefore, instant application may be allowed and criminal proceedings may be quashed.

4. Learned counsel for the opposite party No. 2 has nodded the factum of the compromise entered into between the parties and he has no objection, in case the matter is referred before the court below for verification of compromise. It is further submitted that opposite party no. 2 is no more inclined to prosecute the criminal proceeding against the applicants. Therefore, instant application may be allowed and criminal proceedings against the applicants may be quashed.

5. Learned A.G.A. has no objection in referring the matter before the court below for verification of compromise.

6. In this conspectus, as above, both the parties are hereby directed to appear before the court below along with compromise deed in the week commencing 11.5.2026 to get their compromise verified. The learned court concerned, in turn, shall verify the same in presence of both the parties after recording their statements and submit its verification report on or before the next date fixed.

7. Put up as fresh on 26.05.2026, along with compromise verification report submitted by the court concerned.

8. Learned counsel for applicants also directed to file supplementary affidavit annexing the original/certified copy of the compromise application as well as compromise verification report by the next date fixed.

9. Interim order, if any, is extended till the next date of listing.
