1. Heard Sri Anand Prakash Srivastava, learned counsel for the revisionist and learned AGA for the State.
2. This criminal revision has been filed by the revisionist with prayer to set aside the impugned judgment and order dated 03.09.2025 passed by the Principal Judge, Family Court, Varanasi in Misc. Case No. 1237 of 2023 (Bachau Patel Vs. Gauri Shanker), under Section 125 Cr.P.C., whereby the revisionist has been directed to pay Rs.6,000/- per month each to the opposite party nos.2 and 3 from the date of filing of the application as interim maintenance.
3. The sole contention of the learned counsel for the revisionist is that opposite party nos. 2 and 3 are the parents of revisionist. It is further submitted that opposite party no. 2 owns approximately four bighas of agricultural land, and his two brothers also support him in carrying out agricultural activities. However, despite this fact, the trial court has awarded huge amount of maintenance in favour of opposite party nos. 2 and 3, which is excessive and exorbitant.
4. Matter requires consideration.
5. Issue notice to the opposite party no.2 and 3 returnable at an early date. Steps be taken within one week.
6. Learned counsel for the opposite parties may file their counter affidavit within three weeks. Rejoinder affidavit, if any, may be filed within one week thereafter.
7. Put up on 10.04.2026 as fresh.

8. Till the next date of listing, order dated 03.09.2025 passed by the Principal Judge, Family Court, Varanasi in Misc. Case No. 1237 of 2023 (Bachau Patel Vs. Gauri Shanker), under Section 125 Cr.P.C. shall remain stayed provided the revisionist shall continue to pay the monthly maintenance allowances of Rs. 3000/- per month each to the opposite party nos.2 and 3.

9. In case of default by the revisionist, interim protection granted shall automatically stands vacated
