1. List revised.
2. Heard Sri Sanjay Kumar Dubey, learned counsel for the applicants, Sri Ashwani Kumar Mishra, learned counsel for the opposite party no.2 and Sri Birendra Pratap Singh, learned counsel for the State and perused the records.
3. Learned counsel for the applicants argued that the parties have entered into compromise which is dated 27.11.2025, copy of the said compromise is annexed as Annexure no. 6 to the affidavit in support of present 528 BNSS application. It is argued that as such the present proceedings be quashed.
4. Looking to the facts of the case, it is provided that the applicants shall file the said compromise within a period of two weeks from today before the court concerned who shall verify the same within two weeks thereafter and send its report to this Court.
5. Learned counsel for the parties shall be at liberty to file the order passed by the court concerned regarding verification of the compromise, if any, through a supplementary affidavit.
6. List on 22.04.2026.
7. Till the next date of listing, no coercive action shall be taken against the applicants- Manish Kumar Kaushik and Rahul Singh @ Rahul Chaudhary @ Fauji, in Special Session Trial No. 153 of 2022 (State Vs. Manish Kumar Kaushik and others), arising out of Case Crime No. 297 of 2021, under Sections 323, 504, 308 I.P.C. and Section 3(2)va SC/ST Act, Police Station Hathras Gate, District Hathras, pending before the Special Judge, SC/ST Act, Hathras.

8. The applicants and the opposite party no.2 shall remit back the compensation received by them from the State Exchequer in the appropriate head of the Government for which the court concerned shall seek a report from the District Magistrate concerned and the District Social Welfare Officer concerned about the amount as paid to them as compensation and the pass appropriate orders for its depositing back.

9. The order verifying the compromise, if any, shall also mention in it the factum regarding the amount of compensation taken by the applicant and the opposite party no.2 and its remittance.

10. The amount shall be calculated after adding compound interest to it from the date it has been paid till the date of its repayment.
