**HON'BLE PRAVEEN KUMAR GIRI, J.**

1. Heard Sri Vineet Kumar Dubey, learned counsel for the applicants and Sri Shashidhar Pandey, learned counsel for the State.

2. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that he has filed the instant application under Section 528 BNSS with the relief which has been mentioned in the prayer clause of the application. The relief which has been mentioned in the application is delineated below:-

*"It is, therefore, most respectfully prayed that this Hon'ble Court of may graciously be pleased to allow the instant Criminal Misc. Application filed under Section 528 the Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 and this Hon'ble Court may graciously be pleased to quash the entire proceeding of Criminal Case No.1081/2022 (State Vs. Vijay Pandey and Others) in connection with Case Crime No.0037/2022 arising out of Cognizance and Summoning order dated 12.10.2022 passed by the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-III, Jaunpur in the aforesaid case and pleased to quash the charge sheet dated 30.07.2022 submitted by Investigating Officer in Case Crime No.0037/2022, under Section 498-A, 504, 506 of the IPC and Section 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.*

*It is further prayed that the Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to stay the further proceeding of Criminal Case No.1081/2022 (State Vs. Vijay Pandey and Others) in connection with Case Crime No.0037/2022, under Section 498-A, 504, 506 of the IPC and Section 3/4 of the Dowry*

*Prohibition Act, Police Station-Pavara, District-Jaunpur, pending before the Court of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-III, Jaunpur, during the pendency of the instant application before this Hon'ble Court, otherwise applicant shall suffer irreparable loss and injury.*

*And/or pass such other and further order which this Hon'ble court may deem and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.. fit"*

3. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that applicant no.1 is husband of O.P. No.2 and one opportunity may be given to the parties to settle the dispute by referred the matter to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for which the applicant is ready to deposit the cost, which may be fixed by this Court.
4. Learned State Counsel submits that one opportunity may be granted to the parties for resolution of their dispute through mediation proceedings.
5. In view of aforesaid submissions, the matter is referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre. The applicants are directed to deposit Rs.35,000/-, by 10.03.2026, in the account head of the Registrar General, Mediation and Conciliation Centre, Allahabad High Court by way of bank draft or through e-Payment gateway (available on the official website of Hon'ble High Court i.e. "**ePayment for Mediation**"). Out of the aforesaid amount, Rs.30,000/-, shall be paid to O.P. 2 for her appearance before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre. The Mediation and Conciliation Centre is directed to issue notice to O.P. No.2 fixing date for mediation and arrange two mediators for the mediation proceedings. After completion of mediation proceedings, the Registrar, AHCMCC shall submit its report by the next date fixed in the matter.
6. Put this case on 04.05.2026 as fresh along with report of Mediation and Conciliation Centre.
7. Till the next date of listing, further proceedings of Criminal Case No.1081/2022 (State Vs. Vijay Pandey and Others) in connection with Case Crime No.0037/2022 arising out of Cognizance and Summoning order dated 12.10.2022 passed by the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-III, Jaunpur shall remain stayed.

8. In case, the amount as directed is not deposited by the applicants, this interim order shall automatically stand vacated and the case shall be listed as fresh before this Court immediately.
