1. Heard Mr. Brajesh Shukla, learned counsel for the petitioner, Mr. Pankaj Kumar, learned Standing Counsel for the State-respondents and Mr. Arun Kumar Pandey, learned counsel for the respondent-Consolidation Committee.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner was allotted chak on the plot in question by the consolidation authorities. He further submitted that in pursuance of the allotment made by the authorities the petitioner has developed his plot. He further submitted that in the proceeding under Section 42-A of U.P.C.H. Act, the chak which was allotted to the petitioner at the appropriate stage of consolidation operation has been disturbed which is illegal exercise of jurisdiction under Section 42-A of U.P.C.H. Act. He further submitted that the revision filed by the petitioner has also been dismissed in arbitrary manner.
3. Matter requires consideration.
4. Issue notice to respondent no.5 returnable at an early date.
5. Steps be taken within two weeks.
6. Respondent nos.1 to 6 shall file counter affidavit within six weeks.
7. Petitioner shall file rejoinder affidavit within two weeks thereafter.
8. List this case in the daily cause list on 18.2.2026.

9. Until further orders of this Court, the effect and operation of the order dated 28.3.2025 passed by Consolidation Officer and order dated 29.11.2025 passed by Deputy Director of Consolidation shall remain stayed.
