1. Heard Sri Brijesh Kumar Singh, learned counsel for the applicants, learned A.G.A. for the State and Sri Vinay Kumar Tiwari, learned counsel for the opposite party no. 2.

2. The present application has been filed with the prayer to quash the entire proceedings of S.T. No. 79 of 2020 (State Vs. Pankaj @ Muraj and others), as well as Charge Sheet dated 21.01.2020 as Charge Sheet No. 008 of 2020, arising out of Case Crime No. 381 of 2018, under Sections 498A, 323, 504, 506 I.P.C. and Section 3/4 D.P. Act against the applicant no. 1, under Sections 498A, 323, 504, 506, 313 I.P.C. and Section 3/4 D.P. Act against the applicant nos. 2 and 3 and under Sections 498A, 323, 504, 506, 376, 313 I.P.C. and Section 3/4 D.P. Act against the applicant no. 4, Police Station Bhadohi, District Bhadohi, as well as impugned summoning order dated 03.03.2020, pending in the court of learned Special Additional Sessions Judge, (POCSO)-Ist, Bhadohi, Gyanpur on the basis of compromise dated 04.12.2025.

3. It is submitted by learned counsel for the applicants that the applicants and opposite party no. 2 have entered into a compromise and they have amicably settled their dispute outside the court and no dispute is pending between them. Learned counsel for the opposite party no. 2 has also agreed on the submission of learned counsel for the appellants that parties have entered into a compromise.

4. Compromise, if any, entered in between the parties can best be

ascertained by the trial court, as such, compromise has to be duly verified in presence of the parties before the trial court.

5. Accordingly, for the purpose of verification of the compromise, applicants as well as opposite party no.2 will appear before the trial court along with original compromise deed in the **week commencing 06.04.2026** and the learned trial court shall proceed to verify the compromise-deed. If the aforesaid compromise is verified, a report to that effect shall be prepared by the trial court and the same shall be sent to this Court on or before the next date fixed.

6. Put up this case as fresh on **28.04.2026**.
