1. Heard Sri Amit Daga, learned Senior counsel assisted by Sri Harish Kumar, learned counsel for the applicant, Sri Raghuvansh Misra, learned counsel for opposite party no. 2, learned A.G.A for the State and perused the record.

2. At the outset, learned Senior counsel assisted by Sri Harish Kumar, contended that being aggrieved by the earlier order passed by this Court, the opposite party no. 2 (Divya Sharma) has preferred a petition under appropriate provisions before the Hon'ble Supreme Court, whereby vide order dated 03.02.20206, the matter has been referred to the Mediation Centre of the Supreme Court. The parties have also appeared before the Mediation Centre. The applicant in the instant case has also been impleaded in the aforesaid case pending before the Mediation Centre of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

3. In the light of aforesaid facts, the learned Senior Counsel prayed for quashing of the matter, which is already under consideration before Mediation Centre of the Hon'ble Supreme Court. As the matter is same which is before this Court as well as before the Hon'ble Supreme Court, therefore, it would not be as per law and practice established under the procedure warranting interference in the matter, already pending before the higher Court.

4. At this stage, it would be in the interest of justice to expect that the

parties should make possible efforts before the Hon'ble Supreme Court to get the matter amicably settled.

5. Put up this case as fresh 10.03.2026.

6. In the meantime, if the learned counsel for opposite party no. 2 desires, he may file counter affidavit on which the learned counsel for the applicant, if also feels like, may file rejoinder affidavit.
