1. Heard Sri Rakesh Kumar Pandey, learned counsel for the applicant, Sri Anil Kumar Ojha, learned A.G.A. for the State as well as Sri Ashish Kumar Dubey, learned counsel for opposite party no. 2 and perused the record.
2. It is submitted by learned counsel for the applicant that the applicant and opposite party no. 2 have entered into a compromise and they have amicably settled their dispute outside the court and no dispute is pending between them. Learned counsel for the opposite party no. 2 has also agreed on the submission of learned counsel for the appellants that parties have entered into a compromise.
3. Compromise, if any, entered in between the parties can best be ascertained by the trial court, as such, compromise has to be duly verified in presence of the parties before the trial court.
4. Accordingly, for the purpose of verification of the compromise, applicant as well as opposite party no.2 will appear before the trial court along with original compromise deed in the **week commencing 11.05.2026** and the learned trial court shall proceed to verify the compromise-deed. If the aforesaid compromise is verified, a report to that effect shall be prepared by the trial court and the same shall be sent to this Court on or before the next date fixed.
5. Learned counsel for the applicant is directed to file supplementary

affidavit annexing the compromise as well as proceedings of verification of compromise by next date fixed.

6. List this case on **26.05.2026**.

7. Interim order, if any, is extended till the next date of listing.
