1. Heard learned counsel for the applicants, learned counsel for the opposite party no. 2, learned AGA for the State of U.P. and perused the record.
2. Learned counsel for the applicants has produced the photocopy of the supplementary affidavit in which the original compromise has been filed, which is taken on record as the same is not on record.
3. Office is directed to search out the supplementary affidavit dated 02.02.2026 and place it on record by the next date.
4. Learned counsel for the applicants argued that the parties have entered into compromise, copy of which is annexed as annexure no. S.A.-1 at page no.6 of the supplementary affidavit. It is argued that as such the present proceedings be quashed.
5. Looking to the facts of the case, it is provided that the applicant shall file the said compromise within a period of three weeks from today before the court concerned who shall verify the same within three weeks thereafter and send his report to this Court.
6. List after eight weeks.
7. Till the next date of listing, no coercive action shall be taken against the applicants in Case No. 59618 of 2024 (State vs. Himanshu Roliyan and others) arising out of cognizance and summoning order dated 09.09.2024 passed by the court of learned Civil Judge (J.D.), FTC-I, (Crime Against

Women), Ghaziabad in Case Crime No. 46 of 2024, under Sections 498-A, 323, 504, 506, 406 I.P.C. and Section 3/4 D.P. Act, Police Station Mahila Thana, District Rural (Commissionerate Ghaziabad).

8. Learned counsels for the parties are also at liberty to file the order of compromise through an affidavit in the present matter.
