1. Heard learned counsel for the applicants, learned counsel for the opposite party No. 2, learned A.G.A. for the State and perused the record.
2. The present application under Section 528 B.N.S.S. has been preferred to allow the present application and to quash the Summoning Order dated 27.10.2025 passed by Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Court No. 4, Moradabad as well as entire proceeding of Complaint Case No. 34189 of 2024 (Usha Devi Yadav Vs. Aditya Yadav and others) under Sections 504, 506 IPC, Police Station-Majhaura, District-Moradabad, pending in the Court of ACJM, Court No. 4, Moradabad.
3. Learned counsels for the parties states that they consent to refer the matter to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, High Court Allahabad, for amicable settlement of the dispute.
4. Accordingly, the matter is referred to Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court. The applicants are directed to deposit a sum of Rs. 5,000/- by way of demand draft/pay order in the name of Allahabad High Court, Mediation and Conciliation Centre (AHCMCC) within a period of 15 days from today which shall be retained by the Mediation and Conciliation Centre.
5. The matter is referred to the Mediation Centre with the direction that same may be tried to be resolved after giving notices to the opposite party. The Mediation Centre will submit its report in the matter within three months.
6. List this case on 18.05.2026 in the daily cause list before the appropriate

Bench alongwith the report of Mediation Centre.

7. Till the next date of listing, no coercive measures shall be taken against the applicants in Complaint Case No. 34189 of 2024 (Usha Devi Yadav Vs. Aditya Yadav and others) under Sections 504, 506 IPC, Police Station-Majhaura, District-Moradabad.

8. It is made clear that in case of default in depositing the amount within the aforesaid period, the applicants cannot avail the benefit of this order.
