1. On the prayer of the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner leave is granted to file supplementary affidavit before the Regular Bench.
2. The revisional application has been preferred by challenging the judgement and order dated 15<sup>th</sup> December, 2025 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Fast Track Third Court, Alipore in Criminal Appeal No. 249 of 2025 (Sri Amit Roy vs. Trina Roy) filed under Section 29 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 whereby the order dated 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2025 passed by the Judicial Magistrate, 9<sup>th</sup> Court, Alipore in Domestic Violence Case No. AC/2987/2024 directing the petitioner husband to pay the opposite party no. 2 wife Rs. 1,50,000/- per month as interim maintenance was not set aside and instead only marginally modified fixing the maintenance at Rs. 1,20,000/- per month.
3. The revisional application is required to be heard and as such the petitioner is directed to effect service upon the opposite party and file affidavit of service before the Regular Bench.

4. Considering the amount of maintenance as granted by the learned Appellate Court which stands at Rs.1,20,000/- per month, this Court directs that till the matter is taken up for hearing the petitioner shall continue to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- per month which shall also include the school fees of the child till the disposal of the revisional application. The final amount of maintenance, if any, shall be subject to the final decision in the revisional application.
5. The order dated 15<sup>th</sup> December, 2025 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Fast Track Third Court, Alipore in Criminal Appeal No. 249 of 2025 (Sri Amit Roy vs. Trina Roy) filed under Section 29 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 is modified accordingly till disposal of the revisional application.
6. Pending hearing of the revisional application the proceeding before the learned Judicial Magistrate, 9<sup>th</sup> Court, Alipore in Domestic Violence Case No. AC/2987/2024 be stayed till 30<sup>th</sup> March, 2026 or until further order whichever is earlier.
