The present criminal revision has been preferred against an order and judgment dated 29.09.2021 passed by the Learned Additional Sessions Judge, Fast Track Court-II, Diamond Harbour at South 24-Parganas in connection with Criminal Appeal No. 03 of 2012 arising out judgment and order dated 29.09.2012 passed by the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Diamond Harbour at South 24-Parganas, in GR No. 372 of 2006, thereby partly dismissing the criminal appeal and holding them guilty of committing offences punishable under Sections 323/448/506/427/34 of Indian Penal Code , 1860 and sentencing the petitioners to undergo simple imprisonment for a period of 6 months and to pay of Rs. 1000/- (One Thousand) in

default to suffer further simple imprisonment for one month each for the offence punishable under Section 323 of the Indian Penal Code and to further pay a fine of Rs. 500/- (Five Hundred) for the offence punishable under Section 448 of the Indian Penal Code , Rs. 500/- (Five Hundred) for the offence punishable under Section 506 of the Indian Penal Code , Rs. 500/- (Five Hundred) for the offence punishable under Section 427 of the Indian Penal Code in total Rs. 1500 (Fifteen Hundred) each in default suffer further simple imprisonment for ten days each for the offences punishable under Section 448/506/427/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

As this is an order of conviction and there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners, let an administrative notice be issued through the learned Registrar Administration (L & OM) upon the petitioners.
