Upon perusal of the written complaint of Opposite Party No. 2, it appears that the dispute between the petitioners and Opposite Party No. 2 primarily pertains to the installation of an electricity meter and consumption of electricity.

The dispute, as it presently stands, appears to be essentially civil in nature.

In view of the aforesaid, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in connection with G.R. Case No. 347 of 2019 pending before the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sealdah, South 24 Parganas, arising out of Tangra Police Station Case No. 18 of 2019 dated February 10, 2019, under Sections 323/406/384/34 of the Indian Penal Code, for a period of twelve (12) weeks from the date hereof.

Let a copy of the application be served upon the opposite parties, with intimation that the matter shall be taken up for hearing after six (6) weeks. The petitioners shall file an affidavit of service to that effect on the next date of hearing.

List the matter after six (6) weeks under the heading
“Contested Application.”

The State shall produce the case diary on the next date of
hearing.
