The petitioner herein has assailed the order dated 9.9.2025 by which the court below had allowed the prayer of the accused person for discharging him under Section 498A and 307 of the IPC respectively.

Being aggrieved by the aforesaid order, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the court below failed to appreciate that the materials collected during investigation clearly disclosed repeated acts of physical assault and mental cruelty inflicted upon the petitioner by her husband, which squarely falls within the ambit of Section 498A/307 of the IPC. He further submits that the court below while passing the cryptic order in support of the prayer for discharging the petitioner, failed to consider that the allegation of the complainant is supported by contemporaneous medical records, which unmistakably established the persistent cruelty and brutality meted out to her and thereby negate the finding that the allegations are trivial or exaggerated.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, the application stands admitted.

Petitioner is directed to serve a copy of the application upon the State through the office of the Public Prosecutor, High Court, Calcutta and upon the opposite party no. 2 by speed post intimating the next date of hearing and to file affidavit of service on the returnable date.

Let the matter appear on 8th May, 2026 under the heading **“Contested Application”**.

Petitioner will be at liberty to pray for an accommodation before the court below on 24th April, 2026 and will also be at liberty to pray for interim relief, if any, after serving copy to the opposite parties.
