1. The petitioner participated for appointment in the post of Constable (GD) in Central Armed Police Forces (CAPFs) and SSF, Rifleman (GD) in Assam Rifles, and Sepoy in Narcotics Control Bureau Examination, 2025.

2. The petitioner questions the action of the authority in incorporating his name in the list of withheld candidates.

3. Learned advocate for the respondents raises a preliminary objection with regard to the maintainability of the writ petition before this Court. It has been submitted that this Court does not have the territorial jurisdiction to entertain the prayer of the petitioner.

4. The petitioner appeared in the Computer Based Examination at Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh within the Central region. The instant writ petition has been

filed before this Court by impleading the officer of the Eastern region. The Eastern region officer does not have the relevant documents in respect of the petitioner and is not in a position to provide any instruction in the matter.

5. Learned advocate representing the petitioner intends to revert with further instruction.

6. On such prayer, re-list the matter on 20th March, 2026.
