1. This revisional application seeks expeditious disposal of Complaint Case No.270 of 2022 pending before learned District Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Kolkata Unit-III (South) at Alipore.
2. Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the said complaint case is at the stage of argument yet, the same has been pending since long.
3. In view of the nature of the order proposed to be passed, prior service of the revisional application along with a notice is not being directed, however, the petitioner shall remain obliged to serve a copy of the revisional application along with a copy of this order upon the opposite parties within a week from date.
