1. Report submitted in Court be taken on record.
2. Report of the State shows that, de facto complainant was informed as to the Death Reference, appeal as also the application for condonation of delay.
3. Appellant and the State are represented.
4. None appears for the de facto complainant.
5. Considering the averments made in the application for condonation of delay and the facts that, the appeal is through Legal Aid and that, appellant suffered death penalty, it would

be appropriate to condone the delay in making and filing the appeal.

6. CRAN/1/2025 is allowed.
7. Let the appeal of the appellant be admitted.
8. Since paper book with regard to Death Reference is ready, department will prepare a supplementary paper book incorporating Memorandum of Appeal of the appellant as filed in CRA (DB) 328 of 2025.
9. List the Death Reference and the appeal in the **Combined Monthly List of November, 2025** since the Monthly List of October, 2025 has already published.
10. Since the paper book in respect of Death Reference is already prepared and the Trial Court Records are before Court, no direction with regard to Trial Court Records are passed in CRA (DB) 328 of 2025.
