1. In course of hearing of this matter learned advocate representing the opposite party no.2 places before this Court an order dated 12<sup>th</sup> August, 2025 passed by a coordinate Bench of this Court in WPA 14652 of 2025, which was filed by the present opposite party no.2 in connection with Sessions Case No.23/2023, which is now pending before the learned Chief Judge, City Sessions Court, Kolkata. He also refers to the observations made by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Transfer Petition (Criminal) No.409 of 2021 which is quoted hereinbelow.

“36.(ix). The Learned Portfolio Judge of the Calcutta High Court is requested to regularly monitor and supervise the trial proceedings in terms of the directions issued hereinabove.”

2. Learned coordinate Bench after hearing the petitioner and considering the order passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in connection with the transfer petition has directed to place the matter before the Hon'ble The Chief Justice, High Court at Calcutta, for proper assignment. Accordingly, the matter was placed before the Hon'ble the Chief Justice for passing necessary assignment and subsequently the Hon'ble the Chief Justice also assigned the same before the Hon'ble Zonal Judge/Portfolio Judge.
3. In view of the above facts and circumstances, since this case filed under Section 528 of BNSS for quashing of the proceeding is pending in connection with the same matter, this Court is also of the same view as expressed by the learned coordinate bench. Accordingly, let this revisional application be also placed before the Hon'ble the Chief Justice for appropriate assignment.
