In Re: An Application for Bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/Under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Kalyani Police Station case no. 977 of 2025 dated 26.09.2025 under Sections 318(2)/336(3)/337/338/340(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that petitioner is in custody for 192 days and charge-sheet has been submitted. However, charges are yet to be framed.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for bail as the case involves falsification for Aadhaar, Pan and School Certificate along with other relevant identity cards. The allegations relate that the same were being manufactured and were handed over to foreign nationals.

Having considered the allegations and the fact that charges have not yet been framed, I am not inclined to release the petitioner on bail at this stage.

Petitioner will renew his prayer for bail after the stage of consideration of charges is over before the learned trial Court.

Accordingly, CRM (M) 351 of 2026 is **dismissed**.
