1. Leave is granted to the petitioner to file the supplementary affidavit annexing necessary documents for effective adjudication of the instant writ petition.
2. It appears therefrom that the petitioner applied for recruitment in the Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing. An interview letter was issued to her for appearing in the interview. Her name featured in the list of candidates shortlisted for interview and interview letter was issued to her. She came down all the way from Birbhum to appear in the interview in Kolkata but then she was not permitted to appear in the interview.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner asserts that the petitioner does possess the requisite qualification for appearing in the interview. She has, however, not been made aware of any reason restraining her to appear in the interview.
4. None represents the West Bengal Health

Recruitment Board. Learned counsel for the State seeks accommodation for obtaining necessary instructions.

5. The West Bengal Health Recruitment Board is, therefore, directed to revert with a report by April 2, 2026, when this matter shall once again appear, serving a copy of the same upon the learned counsel for the petitioner in advance.
6. The petitioner is directed to communicate this order to the Board.
7. All parties are to act on the server copy of this order duly downloaded from the official website of this court.
8. Certified copy of this order, if applied for, shall be made available to the parties.
