Prima facie, it appears that registration of the F.I.R. simultaneously under Sections 406/409/420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 cannot be sustained.

In view of the aforesaid, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in connection with G.R. Case No. 1002/2023, pending before the Court of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Chanchal, Malda which arose out of Harischandrapur Police Station Case No. 315/2023 dated 12.04.2023 under Sections 406/409/420 of the Indian Penal Code, for a period of twelve (12) weeks from the date hereof.

Let a copy of the application be served upon the opposite party, with intimation that the matter shall be taken up for hearing after six weeks. The petitioner shall file an affidavit of service to that effect on the next date of hearing.

List this matter after six weeks under the heading "Contested Application."
