1. Affidavit-of-service filed today be kept on record.
2. Since, due to *bona fide* inadvertence, the opposite party nos. 5 to 8 in CAN 1 of 2026 were omitted to be added in the appeal, CAN 1 of 2026 is allowed, thereby directing the said omitted parties to be added as respondents in the appeal.
3. There will be no order as to costs.
4. Necessary consequential corrections to the cause title of the memorandum of appeal and the connected stay application shall be carried out by the learned Advocate-on-record for the appellants during the course of the day.
5. On the prayer of learned counsel for the appellants, the appellants are directed to file the certified copy of the Trial Court's decree in the Department, also during the course of the day.



6. Subject to the above directions, the appeal is taken up for hearing under Order XLI Rule 11 of the Code of Civil Procedure.
7. At the time of hearing under Order XLI Rule 11 of the Code of Civil Procedure, we find that an extremely short point is involved in the appeal.
8. Accordingly, this Court intends to dispose of the appeal along with the admission hearing, subject to hearing the respondents.
9. We intend to adopt such procedure in order to save the respondents' time and unnecessary prolongation of litigation before this Court.
10. Accordingly, the learned Advocate for the appellants is requested to serve copies of the memorandum of appeal as well as a further copy of the stay application on the learned Advocate appearing for the respondents during the course of the day.
11. It may be noted that pursuant to the above direction, such copies are handed over here and now.
12. In order to enable learned counsel for the respondents to prepare himself, let the matter be listed next on July 20, 2026 under the same heading.
