This revisional application assails an order dated January 31, 2026 passed by the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Additional Court at Hooghly in Title Suit No. 178 of 2016 whereby the petitioner's prayer for adjournment for further cross-examination of DW 2 has been declined and evidence of DW 2 has been closed.

2. Mr. Chakraborty, learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that adjournment on the said date was necessitated since the petitioner had taken a change and the freshly engaged learned Advocate required some time to prepare for cross-examination. It is submitted that the learned Trial Court should have considered such prayer in the right earnest and granted an adjournment.

3. Having heard Mr.Chakraborty, learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner and having perused the material-on-record, this court is of the prima facie view that one further opportunity may have been granted to the petitioner to

conclude cross-examination of DW 2. Accordingly, the learned Trial Court is requested to adjourn the proceedings scheduled to be taken up today to a date later than the date on which the present revisional application is made returnable.

4. The petitioner shall serve a copy of the revisional application along with notice on the opposite parties as well as the learned Advocate representing them in the learned Trial Court intimating them that the matter shall be taken up next on July 13, 2026.

5. The petitioner shall file affidavit of service to that effect on the returnable date.

6. The petitioner shall be at liberty to communicate the gist of the order to the learned Advocate representing the petitioner before the learned Trial Court.
