1. The revisional application has been preferred by the wife/petitioner praying for transfer of Matrimonial Suit no. 35 of 2026 pending before the learned Additional District Judge, Hooghly, FTC-I at Chandannagar to any learned Court at Baruipur, South 24 Parganas.
2. It is the case of the petitioner/wife that she is residing at Manikpur, Naskar Para, Rajpur, Sonarpur(M), South 24 Parganas, Harinavi, Police Station-Sonarpur, West Bengal, 700148.
3. On the other hand the husband/opposite party is a resident of Kundughat Road, Chandannagar(p), Chandannagar, Hooghly, West Bengal 712136 and has filed the Matrimonial suit at Chandannagar Court.
4. The petitioner/wife now prays that the suit being Matrimonial Suit No. 35 of 2026 pending before the learned Additional District Judge, Hooghly, FTC-I at Chandannagar be transferred to any learned Court at Baruipur, South 24 Parganas.

5. Accordingly, in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***N.C.V. Aishwarya vs A.S. Saravana Karthik Sha, in Civil Appeal No(s). 4894 of 2022 (arising out of SLP (C) No(s). 16465 of 2021), decided on July 18, 2022, (Para 11, 12)***, the revisional application is required to be heard in presence of the opposite party.

6. Petitioner is directed to serve upon the opposite party and file affidavit of service on the next date of hearing.

7. Pending hearing of the revisional application under Section 24 of the Civil Procedure Code, the proceedings in Matrimonial Suit No. 35 of 2026 pending before the learned Additional District Judge, Hooghly, FTC-I at Chandannagar be stayed till 17th June, 2026 or until further order whichever is earlier.
