1. Heard the submission of the learned advocate representing the petitioners. It is submitted that a number of proceedings are pending between the parties including the custody of the child. It is further submitted in connection with a proceeding, one CRR 2687 of 2025 was preferred as the warrant of arrest was issued against the present petitioners and pursuant to the direction passed by the coordinate Bench, such warrant of arrest was quashed and the petitioners were directed to appear before the learned trial court on the next date of hearing, that is, on August 12, 2025, which they have duly complied with.

2. This Court, prima facie, finds lack of necessary ingredients to attract the offences against which the complaint was lodged as well as the charge sheet has been submitted, specially the present petitioner nos.2 and 3 are concerned. Therefore, an arguable case has been made out for which the matter is required to be heard.

3. The petitioners are directed to serve copies of this revisional application upon the State of West Bengal, service through the office of the learned Public Prosecutor, High Court,

Calcutta, and upon the opposite party no.2 through Speed Post and to file Affidavit-of-Service on the next date of hearing.

4. Let the matter appear before the regular Bench three weeks hence under the heading "Contested Application". The prosecution is directed to produce the Case Diary on the next date of hearing.

5. Let there be stay of all further proceedings pending before the learned court qua the petitioner nos.2 and 3 till April 30, 2026 or until further orders, whichever is earlier

6. All parties shall act on the server copies of this order duly downloaded from the official *website* of this Court.

7. Criminal Section is directed to supply certified copies of this order to the parties, if applied for, upon compliance of all necessary formalities.
