1. Affidavit of service and supplementary affidavit filed by the petitioner in Court today be kept with the records.
2. The petitioner participated in the recruitment process for the post of Constable (GD) in Central Armed Police Forces. He submits that despite clearing all the examinations required for recruitment, his name has been illegally published in the list of withheld candidates.
3. The reason for withholding the candidature of the petitioner is not disclosed.
4. Learned advocate representing the respondent seeks time to revert with instruction in the matter.
5. After filing of the writ petition, the petitioner has been communicated by a letter dated February 10, 2026 that he has been found to be medically unfit for the post of Constable (GD) in CAPF.
6. The petitioner challenges the same and relies upon the medical report which clearly states that the petitioner is fit for the job.

7. Learned advocate representing the Union of India shall revert with instruction with regard to the reason for enlistment of the petitioner in the list of withheld candidates and the ground for issuing the communication dated February 10, 2026 by treating the petitioner medically unfit despite a fit certificate issued by the review medical board in his favour.

8. Re-list the matter on April 7, 2026.
