1. Learned advocate for the appellant is present.
2. The application for stay filed by the appellant Insurance Company is taken up for consideration.
3. As the appellant/Insurance Company has deposited the statutory amount of Rs.25,000/- there shall be an ad interim order of stay of the judgment and award dated 4th day of December, 2025, passed by learned Additional District Judge, Fast Track 1st Court, Tamluk, Purba Medinipur in M.A.C. Case No. 480 of 2021 for a period of five weeks from date.
4. The appellant/Insurance Company shall take steps to deposit the entire awarded sum along with interest as directed by the learned Trial Court excluding the statutory amount within five weeks. In the event such deposit is made within a period of

five weeks, the ad interim order of stay shall continue till disposal of the application being CAN 1 of 2026.

5. The learned Registrar General, High Court Calcutta is requested to invest the amount deposited in a fixed deposit of a Nationalized Bank and renew the same from time to time.
6. Let the Trial Court Records be called at the special messenger cost of the appellant to be deposited within two weeks and the informal paper books be prepared on arrival of the Trial Court Records. Service of notice to be completed in the meantime.
7. Liberty to mention after five weeks.
