2. Affidavit-of-Service and Supplementary Affidavit filed by petitioner in Court, are taken on record. Let copy of the said affidavit be served upon the learned counsel for the parties (if not already served).

**I.A. No. CAN 1 of 2026**

3. This application has been filed by the applicant for seeking impleadment as party, is taken up during the course of argument and submits that he has already filed W.P.A. No.26574 of 2024, which is pending consideration before the learned Single Judge. The relief claimed in this PIL and in the writ petition has similarity. Thus, he may be permitted to participate in the proceedings as a party respondent.
4. Mr. Joydip Kar, learned senior counsel for the private respondent nos.15 to 18 submits that two writ petitions have been filed, which are

pending consideration, which has relation with the present relief in W.P.A. No.26574 of 2024 and W.P.A. No.22848 of 2025, however, those writ petitions are not listed today before us.

5. Thus, we deem it proper to direct the learned counsel for the applicant, who has filed I.A. No.CAN 1 of 2026 to file the copies of both the writ petitions alongwith annexures before the next date of hearing so that we will examine as to whether this PIL can be entertained or whether those writ petitions to be decided by learned Single Judge will serve the purpose.
6. Learned counsel for the applicant, who has filed the present CAN, may file appropriate application seeking clubbing of the present PIL alongwith W.P.A. 26574 of 2024 and W.P.A. 22848 of 2025.
7. List this matter after two weeks under the same heading.
