This is an application wherein petitioner has challenged the order dated 25.09.2025 passed by learned Special Court under NDPS Act, Tamluk in connection with PTN No.375 of 2025 corresponding to T.R.(NDPS) 1 of 2025.

By the impugned order learned Court below has rejected the petitioner's prayer for return of the seized vehicle allegedly carrying the seized contraband/ganja.

Being aggrieved by the aforesaid order, learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is ready and willing to give necessary bond and jimma but the Court below without considering the police report, has arbitrarily rejected the petitioner's prayer which is not sustainable in the eye of law.

Having heard learned Counsel for the petitioner, the application is admitted.

Petitioner is directed to serve a copy of application upon the State through the office of the Public Prosecutor, High Court, Calcutta.
