The grievance of the petitioner is directed against illegal grant of Low Tension connection at the premises belonging to the petitioner in premises no. 113, Part Street, Kolkata.

It is alleged on behalf of the petitioner that the above premises enjoys a High Tension connection and there is no question of grant of Low Tension connection.

On behalf of CESC Ltd., a question of maintainability and bonafides has been raised.

In view of the above, there is no scope of passing any interim order. The parties are directed to exchange Affidavits.

Let Affidavit-in-Opposition be filed within a week from date; Reply thereto, if any, be filed a week thereafter.

Let this matter appear on 23<sup>rd</sup> March, 2026.

On behalf of CESC Ltd., it is submitted that there is a serious defect in the writ petition inasmuch as a necessary and proper party one M.A. Leasing and Construction Pvt. Ltd., has been deliberately and mischievously not impleaded as a party-respondent.

It is needless to mention that the principal grievance of the petitioner of the Low Tension connection being granted in the premises, which has High Tension meter should be dealt with by the CESC Ltd. in the proposed Affidavit-in-Opposition.
