1. Affidavit of service filed in Court today be kept with the records.
2. The petitioner prays for grant of proportionate amount of family pension on the ground that he is the disabled dependant son of the deceased employee who was serving the National Institute of Foundry & Forge Technology renamed as National Institute of Advanced Manufacturing Technology.
3. He refers to the order dated August 21, 2023 passed by this Court in the earlier writ petition filed by him being WPA 14102 of 2023 [Goutam De vs. The Union of India & Ors.] wherein the Court directed the authority to consider his representation.
4. Learned advocate representing the authority relies on the communication dated March 31, 2026 and prays for some more time to pass reasoned order in compliance with the direction passed in the writ petition mentioned hereinabove.

5. In view of such submission, hearing of the writ petition stands adjourned till June 8, 2026.
