Although, the instant writ petition has been filed praying for a direction upon the respondent nos.1, 2 and 5 to recover the outstanding dues payable by the respondent no.3 from the retiral benefits of the respondent no.3, Mr. Bhattacharjee, learned counsel representing the petitioner would, however, submit that since the Certificate Officer and Assistant Registrar of Co-operative Societies, Purba Medinipur II, Post Office- Contai is not executing the certificate dated January 3, 2017 and since no effective steps have been taken by the Certificate Officer to execute the certificate excepting attaching the petitioner's salary, appropriate orders may be issued for directing the Certificate Officer to execute the above certificate.

2. Despite service, except the respondent no.4 and the State the other respondents are not represented. However, noting that the certificate dated January 3, 2017 has already been issued, I am of the view that the Certificate Officer being the respondent no.4 should file a report in the form of an affidavit before this court on or before the matter is taken up next, intimating the steps taken for executing of the certificate.
3. Mr. Hossain, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent no.4 would submit that on the returnable date, an affidavit disclosing the details of steps taken by the Certificate Officer shall be filed.
4. Having regard thereto, let this matter stand adjourned and appear in the Monthly List of November 2025.
