1. The affidavit-in-reply against the affidavit-in-opposition of the respondent Nos. 1 to 3 as filed today on behalf of the petitioner is taken on record.
2. On perusal of the entire materials as placed before this Court and after hearing Mr. Manna, learned Advocate for the writ petitioner it appears to this Court that for effective adjudication of the instant writ petition the State of West Bengal is required to be heard.
3. It reveals that in the instant writ petition the respondent Nos. 4 to 8 that is the State of West Bengal and its functionaries have been made parties who are not represented today.
4. It further appears that notices are required to be served upon the respondent Nos. 4 to 8 afresh.
5. In view of such, the writ petitioner is directed to cause serve of notice along with a copy of the instant writ petition upon the respondent Nos. 4 to 8 afresh and such notice is to be served under speed post.

6. Let the matter be listed on September 17, 2024 under the heading “Writ Petition”.
7. The writ petitioner is directed to file affidavit-of-service on the adjourned date.
8. Since by an order dated 15.07.2024 all interim applications being CAN 1 of 2023, CAN 2 of 2023, CAN 3 of 2023 and CAN 4 of 2023 were disposed of the Registry is directed not to show the pendency of those interim applications during the next listing of this case.
9. Liberty is given to the learned Advocate for the writ petitioner to correct the cause title in respect of the respondent Nos. 4 to 8 in Court today.
