Pursuant to the order dated 13th August, 2024 notice of the writ petition was served upon the respondent nos.4 to 8 that is upon the **respondent no.4**, the Assistant Secretary, Government of West Bengal, Home & Hill Affairs Department, General Establishment Branch, Freedom Fighters' Pension Cell, **respondent no.5**, that is the Joint Secretary, Government of West Bengal, Home & Hill Affairs Department, **respondent no.6**, State of West Bengal represented by the Chief Secretary,

Finance Department, **respondent no.7**, the District Magistrate, Purba Midnapore and **respondent no.8**, the Officer-in-Charge, Nanda Kumar Police Station.

3. Despite service, the aforementioned respondent nos.4 to 8 are not represented today. In absence of the aforementioned respondent nos.4 to 8, this Court is not inclined to take up this matter today.

4. Let the matter be listed on September 27, 2024 under the heading "Hearing".

5. Mr. Manna, learned advocate for the petitioner is hereby requested to intimate the next date of hearing to the learned G.P. High Court at Calcutta by issuing a notice in writing along with a server copy of this order and to file the copy of such notice on the adjourned date.

6. The learned G.P. High Court at Calcutta is hereby requested to ensure the representation of the respondent nos.4 to 8 on the adjourned date through a State counsel.

7. The writ petitioner is also requested to communicate this order to the learned Legal Remembrancer, Government of West Bengal, Writers' Buildings, 1st Floor by issuing a similar

such notice along with the server copy of this order and to file the receipted copy on the adjourned date.

8. Similar request is also made to the Legal Remembrancer, Government of West Bengal to ensure that the State and its functionaries are represented on the adjourned date.

9. Department is also directed to serve a copy of this order to the learned Legal Remembrancer for doing his needful.

10. It is also made clear that in the event the State of West Bengal and its functionaries are not represented on the adjourned date, the instant matter would be taken up in their absence.
