1. Present petition has been filed challenging the order passed by the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bidhannagar, North 24 Parganas in complaint case no. 3014 of 2017, complaint case no. 3147 of 2018 and complaint case no. 139 of 2019 whereby the petitioner was convicted for the offence under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act and awarded imprisonments besides direction for the payment of fine.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that all the three judgments were passed on the same day but there is no direction of the court that whether the sentences imposed shall run concurrently or consecutive. Learned counsel submits that in these circumstances the order per se needs to be revised. Learned counsel has placed reliance upon a decision of the Supreme Court in the case of **Igram Vs. State of Uttar Pradesh & Ors.** reported in **(2023) 3 SCC 184.**
3. Along with the petition an application being CRAN 1 of 2026 has also been filed for condonation of delay in filing the petition.

4. Let notice be issued to the opposite party.
5. Affidavit of service be filed.
6. In the meanwhile, let the petitioner file an affidavit as to the fact whether the fine has been deposited or not.
7. During the course of submissions, it has also transpired that the petitioner has also challenged the judgments before the learned Sessions Judge.
8. Let the status report of those appeals be also filed.
9. In the meantime, a nominal role of the petitioner be also called for from the Dum Dum Central Correctional Home.
10. Let the matter be listed on 9<sup>th</sup> April, 2026.
