1. Affidavit-of-service filed on behalf of the petitioners is taken on record.
2. Matter is heard in presence of the learned advocates representing the petitioners, State respondents and Shyama Prasad Mookherjee Port.
3. It is submitted by the learned advocate representing the petitioners that though they are in occupation of the land in question but they are being attempted to be evicted by the respondent no.6 illegally.
4. A communication dated 18th March, 2026 of Officer-in-Charge, South Port PS, Kolkata is placed before this Court and same is taken on record.
5. Learned advocate representing the Port Authorities has submitted that the land in question is owned by the Port Authorities and at present Port Authorities are erecting boundary wall on the land

in question.

6. On query being posed to the learned advocate representing the petitioners regarding their right over the land in question, no documents are produced before this Court in order to assert their right on the said land.
7. Learned advocate representing the petitioners has prayed for accommodation to obtain further instruction.
8. Hearing of this matter stands adjourned.
9. List the matter under the same heading for further consideration on 20th April, 2026.
10. However, this order shall not preclude the Port Authorities to erect the boundary wall on the land in question.
