1. This revisional application is directed against an order dated November 15, 2025 passed by the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), 1st Court at Asansol, Paschim Bardhaman whereby a direction for tracing the property as mentioned in the schedule of the execution application has been made.
2. Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is aggrieved by that portion of the order whereby the learned Executing Court has recorded that the bailiff while executing the decree for realizing the decretal amount of Rs.10,25,303/- failed inasmuch as the property mentioned in the schedule of the execution application could not be traced out by the bailiff. It is submitted that such property was inserted in the execution application without taking any leave of the Court, and that, a writ for possession of the said property, which was not the subject matter of the suit was issued by the Court without any order of attachment.

3. The petitioner shall serve a notice of the revisional application along with a copy thereof upon the opposite party intimating the opposite party that the matter shall be taken up next on April 9, 2026.
4. It is recorded that the question of grant of interim order has not been gone into at this stage.
