1. Affidavit of service filed in Court today is taken on record.
2. It appears from the affidavit of service that the postal article has returned unserved with three endorsements "door locked"; "In Colane" and "Refuse".
3. The petitioner shall serve a copy of the revisional application along with a notice on the learned advocate appearing for the opposite party before the learned Executing Court.
4. Having heard the learned advocate appearing for the petitioner and having considered the material on record, it *prima facie* appears that the learned Executing Court has committed an error of jurisdiction in issuing writ of possession in respect of a property over which no order of attachment had been passed earlier and which did not form part of the decree.
5. In such view of the matter, the learned Executing Court is requested to adjourn the proceedings of the

Execution Case to a date later than the date on which this revisional application is made returnable.

6. List this matter for further consideration as 'upgraded motion' on June 17, 2026.
7. The petitioner shall inform the opposite party about the returnable date intimating to the opposite party that if the opposite party remains unrepresented on the next date fixed, the matter may be taken up in dealt with in the absence of the opposite party.
