7. Leave granted to the learned advocate on record of the petitioner to implead the Regional Provident Fund Commissioner of the Employees Provident Fund Organization as party respondent in the instant writ petition and serve a copy of the writ petition upon the added respondent.
8. The Employees Provident Fund Organization shall also file a report disclosing its stand prior to the adjourned date.
