1) Matter is heard in presence of learned advocates representing the petitioner, State respondents and private respondents.

2) A communication dated 17<sup>th</sup> March, 2026 of Officer-in-Charge of Saktipur Police Station, Murshidabad Police District is filed by the learned advocate representing the State respondents and same is taken on record.

3) It is disclosed in said communication dated 17<sup>th</sup> March, 2026 that in connection with criminal prosecution being Saktipur Police Station Case No. 300/2023 dated 22<sup>nd</sup> December, 2023 under certain provisions of Indian Penal Code charge-sheet was filed

against FIR named accused persons being Charge Sheet No. 61/26 dated 11<sup>th</sup> March, 2026. It is also stated in the communication that in spite of several raids private respondents could not be arrested but ultimately respondent nos. 5 to 9 surrendered before the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Berhampore, Murshidabad on 13<sup>th</sup> February, 2026 and obtained bail.

4) Learned advocate for the petitioner in reference to his complaint dated 2<sup>nd</sup> February, 2026 submits that private respondents are preventing the petitioner from cultivating the land in question and produce of the land is destroyed.

5) Learned advocate representing the private respondents has disputed the contention made on behalf of the petitioner.

6) In the communication dated 17<sup>th</sup> March, 2026 it is not disclosed whether any step has been taken by the authorities of Saktipur Police Station in order to prevent the private respondents from disturbing the petitioner in peaceful possession of the land in question.

7) Let a further report be filed by ten days from date by the Officer-in-Charge of Saktipur Poice Station.

8) List the matter under the same heading on 27<sup>th</sup> April 2026.
